Suggested Toy and Gift Items

Seniors

New slippers, pajamas, socks for men and women, bathrobes, blankets, sweaters, scarves, gloves, small radios, bibles and books (large print), stamps with notepaper sets, toiletries (toilet paper, Kleenex, shampoo, bars of soap), and miniature decorated trees.

Teens

Gift certificates to book stores, record shops, scarf/glove sets, manicure/nail polish sets, radios and CD players (with batteries, if possible), jewelry, DVD's/CD's, t-shirts, caps, etc.

Children ages 3 to 12

New books, stuffed animals, crayons and markers, color and sticker books, activity books, games, dolls, trucks, building blocks, puzzles, fun backpacks, etc. If required, please include batteries to operate the toy.

Homeless Packs

A duffel bag or backpack filled with "basic needs" items, knit caps and gloves, hygiene kits, bottled water, flashlights, kleenex, first-aid kits, emergency blankets, and single-serving foods.
